MARBLE POINT JUSTICE CAMP (GROOTE EYLANDT) – ALTERNATIVE TO CUSTODY PROGRAM NOW ACCEPTING REFERRALS FOR ABORIGINAL MEN

I am pleased to announce that DASA, in partnership with the Anindilyakwa Land Council & the Aboriginal Justice Unit (NTG), has commenced work on a Cultural Rehabilitation Centre as an Alternative to Custody option on Groote Eylandt. Working to deliver upon the aims of the NT Aboriginal Justice Agreement, we will take a whole-person approach to providing therapeutic alternatives to imprisonment that address the underlying causes of offending.

The Marble Point Justice Camp is currently under construction, and we anticipate commencing intakes before the end of 2023, likely beginning in late November. Initially, the residential program will be able to accommodate 16 participants, expanding to 32 beds in 2024. The program will provide Aboriginal men with opportunities to address substance use concerns and provide traumainformed support to tackle the deeper causes of offending.

The Anindilyakwa community is very involved in their own justice system, and we will work closely with local community members, as well as the **Anindilyakwa Community Justice Group**, to ensure all programs are culturally informed and safe.

As you may be aware, DASA presently runs an Alternative to Custody program in Alice Springs (Mparntwe) for Aboriginal women. This program has been evaluated and is proving to be highly successful in terms of both reducing recidivism & improving quality of life for Aboriginal women.

As we finalise the program, facility construction and recruitment, I invite you to consider referring potential participants. The eligibility criteria is as follows:

- Aboriginal or TSI
- Male
- 18 years or older
- Must be a resident of the Northern Territory
- Must have cultural connection to Groote Eylandt, as confirmed by representatives of the Marble Point Justice Camp Referral Group
- Involvement or risk of involvement with the Justice system
